## How To Use the New Scheduling Engine on Windows Based Web Browsers

Powerschool supports the use of the following web browsers for Powerscheduler Scheduling Engine use:

### Supported Browsers

- Firefox - Latest two versions (Windows 7, 8, and 8.1)
- Chrome - Latest two versions (Windows 7, 8, and 8.1)
- Internet Explorer – IE10 (Windows 7 and 8) IE11 (Windows 8 and 8.1)
- Safari – Last release (Windows 7, 8, and 8.1)

### Firefox

1. On the start page, choose PowerScheduler under Applications in the main menu. The Scheduling page appears.
2. Click either the Build or Load link
3. Select the procedure selections as normal.
4. Click "Execute".
5. On the Opening engine.psengine dialog, select Save File, then OK.
6. Click the Downloads icon
7. Double click the engine.psengine file.
8. A java console should pop up, launching the engine.
9. Once completed, select the appropriate (Q) to view the results.

### Chrome

1. On the start page, choose PowerScheduler under Applications in the main menu. The Scheduling page appears.
2. Click either the Build or Load link
3. Select the procedure selections as normal.
4. Click "Execute".
5. Locate the downloads bar (normally on the bottom of the browser)
6. Double click the engine.psengine file.
7. A java console should pop up, launching the engine.
8. Once completed, select the appropriate (Q) to view the results.

### Internet Explorer

1. On the start page, choose PowerScheduler under Applications in the main menu. The Scheduling page appears.
2. Click either the Build or Load link
3. Select the procedure selections as normal.
4. Click "Execute".
5. Locate the Download Dialog, select Open.
6. A java console should pop up, launching the engine
7. Once completed, select the appropriate (Q) to view the results.

### Safari

1. On the start page, choose PowerScheduler under Applications in the main menu. The Scheduling page appears.
2. Click either the Build or Load link
3. Select the procedure selections as normal.
4. Click "Execute".
5. On the Open or Save Dialog, select Save.
6. In the Downloads dialogue, find the engine.psengine file
7. Right click the engine.psengine file, and select Show Containing Folder
8. Select Open With, and click Java™ Platform
9. A java console should pop up, launching the engine
10. Once completed, select the appropriate (Q) to view the results.
